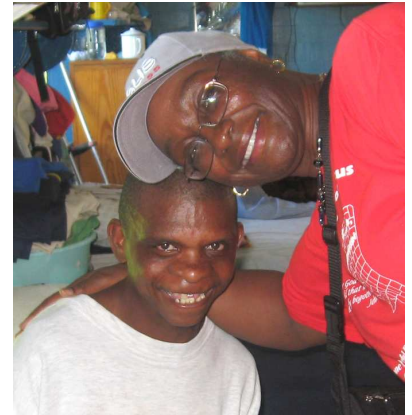


Fast friends with Felix!
